





## HISTORY Pesson

MANSIONS, MOUNDS AND "OLD CABBAGE HEAD" MEMORIALIZE STORIES OF THE BRADENTON AREA'S PAST

FLEEING CIVIL WAR LEADER, A WHITE-COLUMNED MAN-SION, MULTI-STORY MOSS-CLAD TREES, SEA CAPTAINS, AND AN INDIAN MOUND MORE THAN 1,200 YEARS OLD. AWE-INSPIRING ATTRACTIONS THROUGHOUT THE BRADENTON AREA WILL ENRICH YOUR VISIT.

ENTERTAINING EXHIBITS TELL THE STORY OF PEOPLE SUCH AS JOSEPH BRADEN, WHO BUILT A PLANTATION AND A STOCKADE IN THE 1840s. OVER TIME, THE COMMUNITY GREW, HELPED BY THE DEVELOPMENT OF STEAM-BOATS, TRAINS, AGRICULTURAL IMPROVEMENTS AND ELECTRICITY. ALONG THE WAY, COW HUNTERS, FARMERS, FISHERS AND OTHERS BROUGHT COLOR AND COURAGE TO THE FLORIDA FRONTIER.



#### GAMBLE PLANTATION HISTORIC STATE PARK

An antebellum mansion is the centerpiece of the park, buffered by mossy live oaks and a 19th-century atmosphere from its days as a sugar plantation. The white-columned house is furnished like the prosperous plantation owner's home it once was. After the tour, enjoy a walk around the well-shaded grounds.

#### FLORIDA MARITIME MUSEUM

Set in a 1912 schoolhouse, exhibits display boat models, tools, historic photographs, and other items that enliven maritime culture and history. One crowd favorite: seashells from the Gulf of Mexico.

The museum, located in the fishing village of Cortez, includes a folk school on traditional skills, and offers fun classes on net-making, soapmaking and other trades.

#### POWEL CROSLEY ESTATE

This eye-catching mansion, also called Seagate, covers 11,000 square feet and contains 10 bedrooms, 10 bathrooms and living quarters for staff. Built in 1929, it was ahead of its time because it used a steel frame encased in cast stone as well as embedded pipes and wiring to help it withstand fires and hurricanes. It now serves as a stately venue for weddings and meetings.

#### MADIRA BICKEL MOUND STATE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE

At the Madira Bickel Mound State Archaeological Site, you can see a spot that tells stories of Native American life 12 centuries ago. Archaeologists found at least three distinct periods of Native American culture by sifting through sand, shells and debris in the flat-topped, 20-foot-tall mound. Excavations have traced its existence to a time period before 700 AD.



#### MANATEE COUNTY AGRICULTURAL MUSEUM

Tomatoes, celery, citrus and cattle are among the topics in the down-toearth exhibits that recall earlier days of farming. Tools, a silo filler, a 1925 pickup truck and kid-friendly material illustrate how farmers worked diligently to make a living. Exhibits showcase old-time agricultural life, when small family farms were common.



#### PALMETTO HISTORICAL PARK

Discover life before the internet, central air conditioning and other modern creature comforts.

The Cottage Museum was created from a typical 1900s bungalow. Remember that families then tended to be much larger; imagine how everyone lived in the small spaces.

Heritage Station, once a post office, handled mail that arrived via train and steamer.

Palmetto's Carnegie Library served many purposes as the community grew. It has been a town hall and a school library; its archives hold reams of detail about the area and its residents.


#### MANATEE VILLAGE HISTORICAL PARK

More than a dozen exhibits delve into life in the days of dirt roads, blacksmiths, smokehouses and sugarcane mills.

"Old Cabbage Head," a 1913 locomotive, once shuttled turpentine in north Florida. Picnic tables and a train-themed park for children are nearby.

The 1903 Wiggins General Store included a boardinghouse because travel was so difficult for shoppers who came to town from rural areas.

A tiny "strawberry school" from 1908 demonstrates how dramatically education and life have changed. Children attended class only from August to December. From January through July they worked on farms, tending to strawberries and other crops.



#### MUSEUMS

The Bishop Museum of Science & Nature is home to a popular, all-digital planetarium as well as a beloved manatee rehabilitation aquarium. Explore the museum's ancient marine fossils and other local natural and cultural history.

Kids and adults alike love the Florida Railroad Museum. Every weekend, visitors board the diesel trains and spend nearly 90 minutes on one of the many themed rides offered, including an exciting murder mystery. The museum also features a model train exhibit and gift shop.

Agriculture is deeply rooted in the history of Manatee County. Manatee County Agricultural Museum takes great care to share this story, with exhibits on livestock, commercial fishing, horticulture and other activities that ensured the survival and growth of the local community. Tools, equipment and photographs illustrate how local pioneers worked the land and sea, making a living on the Florida West Coast.

Step into Florida history at Manatee Village Historical Park, a collection of historic buildings and artifacts. Visitors will see firsthand what life was

like for pioneers in the mid-19th century, when Manatee County was founded. From a general store and blacksmith to a settler's home and an old schoolhouse, the park grounds paint a vivid portrait of pioneer life.

Inside what was an icehouse in 1920, the small Anna Maria Island Historical Museum tells a big story. Visitors will discover how early island settlers lived and thrived throughout the years-from maritime history to clothing to an old jail that's become one of the most photographed attractions on the island.

#### THEATER

Local playwrights and actors exercise their creative muscles at Theatre Odyssey, a nonprofit company known for producing 10-minute plays submitted by up-and-coming writers.


The Manatee Performing Arts Center hosts a variety of events and performances throughout the year, appropriate for all ages and interests. Its building is stunning-designed in a Spanish Colonial Revival style with touches of Art Deco-and reflects the beauty and charm of local culture.

For more than 70 years The Island Players has provided entertainment for locals and visitors alike on Anna Maria Island. The theater is the oldest in Manatee County, with a vibrant history and historical landmark distinction from the Anna Maria Island Historical Society.

#### MUSIC

Performing a variety of musical styles, featuring both professional and amateur local musicians, The Pops Orchestra strives to bring music to as many people as possible. Affordable tickets make the performances accessible, and audience members enjoy the small theater, where every seat is the best seat in the house.

Local musicians of all ages comprise the Manatee Community Concert Band, which performs 10-12 concerts per season. Concertgoers will enjoy listening to everything from Broadway hits to renowned and beloved classical compositions.



Established by Toby Perlman and her husband, the venerable violinist Itzhak Perlman, The Perlman Music Program (based in New York) provides musical training for young musicians. The Suncoast program in Florida offers a winter residency for these students in Manatee and Sarasota counties, providing further mentoring. This winter training program includes around 20 free or lowcost concerts that are open to the public. The program also presents concerts throughout the season, performed by PMP alumni.

#### SOUTHERN ATELIER

This classic art program is dedicated to teaching realist painting and drawing. Skilled and well-known professional artists teach still life, portrait painting and oil painting fundamentals classes regularly.

#### VILLAGE OF THE ARTS

One of the most visited places in Manatee County, Village of the Arts is a live/work community of colorful homes, restaurants and art galleries. Various gallery owners provide art classes for an immersive, creative experience.

Both professional and volunteer musicians perform classics, opera and signature American music with Anna


Maria Island Concert Chorus & Orchestra. The orchestral season runs from December through March, with four or five different performances at venues throughout Manatee and Sarasota counties, plus their popular "Symphony on the Sand" every November.

Savor one of 32 ice cream flavors, including the astonishing trashcan-a heap of Oreo-cookie ice cream with

three types of candy, plus chocolate-covered almonds. Relax with a sundae, shake, float, ice cream cappuccino or iced coffee as you watch life go by on Anna Maria Island.



#### HOLY COW ICE CREAM & OTHER COOL STUFF

Holy Cow Ice Cream is a very cool stop. This Holmes Beach favorite

scoops up 36 of its flavors, including sugar-free, dairy-free and frozen yogurt options. Dive in to crafted sundaes such as Wet Nuts with maple walnut topping. Or enjoy a handspun shake. Frappes and fruit smoothies round out the sweet lineup.







lows of Sarasota Bay, Palma Sola Bay and the Manatee River. There are plenty of boat launch locations throughout the Bradenton Area for venturing out on your own, or you can hire one of the area's many expert fishing guides, such as Captain J. L. Davis or Hackney Marine Charters, who will take you straight to where they know the fish are biting.

There are boatloads of great fishing options for shore-bound anglers as well. Palma Sola Causeway Park in Palma Sola Bay and Green Bridge Fishing Pier along the Manatee River are spots where the whole family can enjoy a terrific mixed bag of trout, redfish and sometimes even grouper. See breathtaking views of Tampa Bay and Passage Key at Anna Maria Bayfront Park and Rod & Reel Pier on Anna Maria Island, plus enjoy sublime pier fishing for Spanish mackerel, mangrove snapper and giant-sized snook.

If freshwater fishing is what you're after, newly renovated Jiggs Landing along the Braden River has a tackle shop with canoe and cabin rentals and some of the best

shore-bound fishing for largemouth bass, bream and crappie found anywhere.

Just a few miles away, drop a line at Lake Manatee Fish Camp to target big Florida bass and large coppernose bluegill. There's a convenient boat ramp and on-site tackle store, so anglers can stock up on snacks, live bait and a few fishing tips from the friendly staff before heading out to one of the many scenic locations along the shoreline of Lake Manatee State Park.

#### INTRACOASTAL

The 100-mile portion of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway that stretches south from Anna Maria Island is an expanse ripe with incredible saltwater fishing and sightseeing. At the waterway's northernmost point along Anna Maria Island, Cortez Historic Fishing Village harkens back to the days of fish houses where the old salts who pioneered commercial fishing in the area still share their tales of yesteryear.

A short walk away is Bell Fish Company, a working fish house where a variety of freshcaught seafood can be purchased right from the water. Just off the island, thousands of huge tarpon can be seen rolling on the surface of the bay during their annual migration inshore each summer. Egmont Key is one of the best places to witness this phenomenon, and experts, including Charters with Captain Allan Engel and Anna Maria Island Charters, specialize in hooking up guests with their first battle with a 100-plus-pound silver king. Along with fishing offerings, Five O'Clock Charlie Boat Tours and Charters takes visitors on snorkeling excursions into the water surrounding Egmont Key, where a bounty of exotic shells, fish and sea life make for fascinating sights along the shallow seafloor.





Just a few miles off the white-sand beaches of Anna Maria Island, the reefs and mapped wrecks within the Gulf of Mexico provide excellent deepwater fishing opportunities year-round, with a myriad of species to target, including snapper, amberjack and the delectable gag, red and scamp grouper. Farther offshore, guests aboard Team Galati Charters can spend the day trolling for mahi mahi and king mackerel before enjoying a glass of wine at sunset on the way back to the harbor.

For dinner on land, try one of the many local restaurants within the Cortez Historic Fishing Village that offer "catch and cook" options where they'll prepare your freshly caught fish. Best of all, you can pull your boat right up to the dock and relax after your great day of fishing!

#### ON YOUR FEET

Looking to take a hike? Thousands of acres of preserves are wonderful to wander. The largest in the county, Duette Preserve, includes cultural and natural experiences across 21,000 acres. Pick a trail-there are more than a dozen-based on your interest. Of note: a prehistoric mound site, called Carruthers Mound, which dates as far back as 1300 AD. Additionally, at least two endangered/threatened species-the Florida scrub jay and the eastern indigo snake-may be seen at Duette Preserve.

Explore four ecosystems across 145 acres at Rye Preserve: sand pine scrub, oak scrub, oak hammocks and the Manatee

River. For a bit of history, make your way to the Rye Family Cemetery within the preserve to learn more about the county's early pioneer history. Thanks to the variety of ecosystems at Robinson Preserve, a walk may lead you past prickly pear cactus, cabbage palm, live oak, hickory, cedar, saw palmetto and Christmasberry.




#### ANIMAL INSTINCTS

Long-established fishing charters and local captains navigate to the best spots for light tackle and deep-sea fishing. On land, Emerson Point Preserve, Bridge Street Pier and Bradenton Riverwalk are wellknown locations from which to cast a line. Don't forget your fishing license before this unforgettable experience. You'll be hooked!







Start the decompression with a stroll along Old Main Street in downtown Bradenton. Linger over

breakfast at a café, then explore the charming, walkable neighborhood. On Saturdays from October to May, meet local growers and pick up some fresh produce at the Bradenton Farmers' Market.

Waterfront Restaurant

Sit back and soar through the heavens during a 20-minute narrated virtual journey or live star talk in the full-dome planetarium at The Bishop Museum of Science & Nature. Get up-close and personal with celestial objects, or reach out and touch an actual meteorite or moon rock in the museum's exhibits.

Other beaches along the way such as Greer Island and Whitney Beach are more primitive and perfect for a quiet stroll.






